On August 14, 2013 the South Dakota One Call Board issued an Order to Meyer Drainage and Excavating in regards to Complaint Docket OC13-007. The Order called for a total payment amount of \$500, of which \$250 was suspended with conditions. Those conditions were:

- (i) Meyer Drainage and Excavating shall make payment of the \$250 unsuspended penalty within 30 days of issuance of the Order.
- (ii) Meyer Drainage and Excavating must not be found guilty of a One Call violation in the next 12 months.
- (iii) Meyer Drainage and Excavating must attend a spring 2014 South Dakota One Call excavator meeting.
- (iv) Meyer Drainage and Excavating shall conduct an in-house safety meeting for its employees. The meeting shall be held within 30 days of the Order. Documentation shall include the printed and signed names of the meeting participants, details of the material discussed along with the date and length of the meeting. Documentation shall be submitted to the Executive Director of South Dakota One Call.

If any of the conditions were not met the suspended payment amount would also be due. A payment of \$250 was not received at the Public Utilities Commission by September 14, 2013, which means the entire \$500 is now due, no later than October 17, 2013. Please remit payment to:
