**ORDER DISMISSING REQUEST
TO BRING CIVIL ACTION**

On June 28, 2013, NorthWestern Energy filed a complaint against CenturyLink alleging that CenturyLink did not locate within the time period required by South Dakota law. The One Call Enforcement Panel met on July 30, 2013, and determined that probable cause existed to believe that a violation did occur. The Panel recommended a penalty of \$500.00, with \$250.00 suspended based upon certain conditions. CenturyLink did not contest the recommendation. On October 10, 2013, the One Call Board issued an Order Adopting Enforcement Panel Recommendation and to Pursue Collection Action if Necessary. CenturyLink failed to satisfy the conditions of the suspended portion of the fine or to make payment of any portion of the fine. In accordance with SDCL § 49-7A-34, a demand letter for payment of the penalty was sent to CenturyLink on December 4, 2013.

On January 3, 2013, the Public Utilities Commission received payment in full from CenturyLink's contractor.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-28. At its regular meeting on January 7, 2014, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss this docket, as the requirements of the One Call Board's Order had been satisfied in full. It is therefore

ORDERED, that this docket is dismissed.
