On October 16, 2013 the South Dakota One Call Board issued an Order to Swiftec in regards to Complaint Docket OC13-012. The Order called for a total payment amount of \$500, \$250 of which was suspended with conditions. Those conditions were:

- (i) Swiftec shall make payment of the \$250 unsuspended penalty within 30 days of issuance of the Order. This condition was satisfied on October 28, 2013.
- (ii) Swiftec must not be found guilty of a One Call violation in the next 12 months. This condition is pending.
- (iii) Swiftec must attend a spring 2014 South Dakota One Call excavator meeting. This condition is pending.
- (iv) Swiftec shall conduct an in-house safety meeting for its employees. The meeting shall be held within 30 days of the Order, meaning no later than November 16, 2013. Documentation shall include the printed and signed names of the meeting participants, details of the material discussed along with the date and length of the meeting. Documentation shall be submitted to the Executive Director of South Dakota One Call. This condition was to be met no later than November 16, 2013. within 30 days of the Board Order. This condition was not met, which means the suspended amount of \$250 is now immediately due.
