On October 16, 2013 the South Dakota One Call Board issued an Order to CenturyLink in regards to Complaint Docket OC13-016. The Order called for a total payment amount of \$2,000, \$1,000 of which was suspended with conditions. Those conditions were:

- (i) CenturyLink shall make payment of the \$1,000 unsuspended penalty within 30 days of issuance of the Order. **This condition has not been met.**
- (ii) CenturyLink must attend a spring 2014 South Dakota One Call excavator meeting. **This condition is pending.**
- (iii) CenturyLink shall conduct an in-house safety meeting for its employees **and subcontractors**. The meeting shall be held within 30 days of the Order. Documentation shall include the printed and signed names of the meeting participants, details of the material discussed along with the date and length of the meeting. Documentation shall be submitted to the Executive Director of South Dakota One Call. **Names were provided, but not signed and printed names. Details of the discussion and length of the meeting were not provided. This condition has not been met.**
- (iv) CenturyLink must not be found guilty of a One Call violation in the next 12 months. **This condition is pending.**

Because payment of \$1,000 was not made, and because condition (iii) was not fully met, the suspended amount of \$1,000 is now also due, for a total of \$2,000 due and owing to South Dakota One Call.

Please remit payment in the amount of \$2,000 , no later than January 3, 2014 to:
