Inform the excavator of the following requirements for Northern Natural Gas:

- Never excavate within 25 feet of Northern's pipelines without a Northern representative present.
- Prior to excavation near the pipeline, consult the on-site Northern representative for distance requirements.
- Look for evidence of a pipeline including such things as caution signs, pipeline markers, casing vents and above ground piping.
- All excavation within 24-inches of a pipeline shall be by manual means. No mechanical equipment may be used.
- If the location of a planned excavation changes, a new one-call request must be submitted to the state.
- Never assume the location of pipelines because:
  - Pipelines can change directions abruptly between above ground physical evidence.
  - Pipeline depths can vary substantially in short distances.
  - More than one pipeline may be present.
  - Pipelines may have underground connections and appurtenances.
