In accordance with the conditions set forth by the South Dakota One Call Board Enforcement Panel after reviewing One Call Complaint OC14-004 filed against CenturyLink in 2014, you are required to send a representative to attend a Spring Damage Prevention Meeting in 2015 to further education of South Dakota One Call laws and administrative rules. Please note also this requirement in the Panel Recommendation: "Should CenturyLink: contract with another party to perform location of CenturyLink's facilities, a representative from that party shall attend the seminar, as well". Please remember that in addition to the suspended amount due within 30 days of the final South Dakota One Call Board Order, the suspended portion of the penalty amount addressed in the Panel Recommendation will also be due, in the event of non-attendance at one of these meetings.

The Spring Damage Prevention meeting schedule is attached. Also attached is a Record of Attendance form. Please bring two copies of this form to the meeting, after which, you or your representative and I will each sign as proof of attendance. We will then each keep a copy for our records.
