

2. **Excavator Identification:** for Brewer Construction the identification number is 605-787-6437. The operator will confirm the information of the company. Brewer Construction, address: 14990 W Hills View Dr., Piedmont, SD 57769. Call back number will be the same with contact information of Sam Brewer 605-209-1003.
 3. **Type of request being placed;** can be for routine excavation activity, to set an appointment to meet locators at the excavation site, to modify and existing ticket, to report unmarked or incorrectly marked underground facilities, to remark a previously marked excavation site, for a common work type such as sign placement, or to remark a previous excavation site and extend the valid period of the original locate request.

 5. **Caller Name and Company Name:** Brewer Construction

 8. **Contact person or Alternate Contact person with telephone number:** Sam Brewer 605-209-1003
 9. **County or nearest city/township:** city in which locates will be done, : Rapid City is Pennington, Sturgis is in Meade County.
 10. **When work will begin:** this must be 48 hours after the call to One-Call
 11. **Duration:** How long will this job take to complete give an extra day.
 12. **Street address of work site:** Name of street that the work will take place on, the name of the nearest intersecting street, what is the distance and direction from the nearest intersecting street to the excavation site and which side of the street is the excavation site on.
- D. **Type of Work:** what will you be doing at this job examples take out and replace curb/gutter, driveway, sidewalk, etc.
- E. **Depth in Feet:** how deep will you be going.
- F. **Right of Way:** Y/N if unsure answer yes.
- G. **Tunneling or Boring:** We do not do tunneling or boring.
- H. **Explosives:** we do not use explosives
- I. **Township, Range, Section and Quarter.** (only if you have it)
- J. **Specific Excavation Site/Marking Instructions:** be as specific as you can for example: locate from the road at front of property to the front of the home the entire width of the property. (this would get locates for sidewalk, driveway, approach, curb and gutter.
- K. **Remarks:** anything that you may find useful to the locator you will tell them here.


A. **Determining when to provide notification:** South Dakota Law requires that anyone who engages in any type of excavation provide advance notice of at least 48 hours, excluding weekends and holidays, to the SD One-Call System. Excavation is defined as, "any operation which earth, rock, or other material in or on the ground is moved or otherwise displaced by means of tools, equipment, or explosives." Gardening to a depth of 12" and agricultural tilling to 18" are exempted by statute.

South Dakota One-Call Center accepts emergency locate requests 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. An emergency is defined by state law as. "an occurrence which demands immediate action to prevent significant environmental damage or loss of life, health, property, or essential public services including the re-erecting of critically needed traffic control signs or devices." Excavators are reminded that calling in an emergency that doesn't meet this definition is a violation of the law and may be subjected to penalties under SDCL 49-7A-18 & 49-7A-19.

B. **Optional methods for notifying the South Dakota One-Call System:** You can request locates by calling 811 from any phone.

C. **Guidelines for preparing to call South Dakota One-Call:**

1. A specific street or rural address, which has a numbered address on a marked street or avenue that is publicly recorded. A specific mile marker from a state or federal highway. Township, range and a specific quarter section if possible. Latitude/Longitude coordinates, or if information in first three lines of (1.) cannot be provided, the excavation site must be within 1000 feet of the nearest named intersecting street, in addition to the intersecting street, accurate driving directions to the excavation site are highly recommended.



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Location markings are only estimates and the exact locate may vary by up to 18".

Red- Electric power lines, cables conduit and lightning cables

Yellow-gas, oil, steam, petroleum or Gaseous materials

Orange- communication, cable tv, alarm or signal lines, cable or conduit

Blue- water, irrigation or Slurry Lines

Fluorescent Pink- Temporary survey markings

White- Proposed Excavation

Purple- Reclaimed water, irrigation or Drain Line.

After the markings have been made, excavators are required to maintain a minimum clearance of 18 inches between a marked and unexposed underground facility and the cutting edge or point of any power-operated excavating or earth-moving equipment. **IF EXCAVATION IS REQUIRED WITHIN EIGHTEEN INCHES, HORIZONTALLY, OF THE MARKED FACILITY, THE EXCAVATOR SHALL EXPOSE THE FACILITY ONLY BY USE OF HAND EXCAVATION, AIR CUTTING, WATER CUTTING OR VACUUM EXCAVATION IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT DAMAGE THE UNDERGROUND FACILITIES.**

This information is to be kept inside each work truck and if for any reason an employee sees that the locates have not been called on a project work will need to wait until locates have been done. The will first contact Melody in the office at 209-4048 to see if locates have been ordered for the project. She will inform as to if a ticket number is available and when work can start. If no ticket has been ordered you will then need to give her the information or call 811 with the information on this copy and get locates ordered. You will need to remember always to get a confirmation number at the end of each ordered ticket.
