I had not seen the prior notice for this complaint. I apologize for the delay in this response.

It appears that the complaint is for not having locations done prior to work being done on a residence. This is a bit misleading. The work being done was in a development that Krueger Excavating had done both the site and utility

work. We knew where any utilities were on the site and could have done a better job of updating the tickets, but never was there a question where any utility was. They were all put in with our supervision. In any event we had frequently called for locations and flags remained onsite.

The site had been located at least 7 times on these tickets. Work had been going on regularly during this period and the location flags remained largely intact for long periods.
