To whom it may concern:

I need to point out an item in the South Dakota One Call Board Order for Complaint Docket OC14-025, which I believe may have been just an oversight.

Item iii. Respondent shall conduct an in-house safety meeting for its employees to review the One Call laws. The meeting shall be held within 30 days of the final One Call Order. Documentation shall include the printed and signed names of meeting participants, details of the material discussed, and the date and length of the meeting. Documentation shall be submitted to the Executive Director of South Dakota One Call within that 30 day period.

Nelson Construction has met the other requirements of the Order, so I'm hoping that such a meeting will be held in order to avoid having to pay the \$500 Suspended amount. If this meeting can be held and the documentation sent to me by the end of March, I believe the Board will not impose the additional penalty amount. This was actually due by December 17, 2015.
