ORDER GRANTING
WITHDRAWAL OF
COMPLAINT

On April 15, 2013, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission received a complaint from Engbarth Directional Drilling, Inc. (Engbarth), Canistota, South Dakota against CenturyLink, Seattle, Washington. The complaint alleges that CenturyLink was unaware of a duct run and, therefore, failed to mark the facility. May 24, 2013, Engbarth made a written request to withdraw its complaint in this docket.

On June 4, 2013, pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-22 a panel of five One Call Board members (herein "Panel") convened. The Panel considered this matter. The Panel voted unanimously to recommend to the One Call Board that Engbarth's request to withdraw its complaint be granted.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 7, 2013, the South Dakota One Call Board, pursuant to 49-7A-27, reviewed the Panel's recommendation.

It is therefore:

ORDERED, that the request to withdraw the complaint is granted.

The South Dakota One-Call Notification Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-7A, specifically SDCL 49-7A-5, 49-7A-18, 49-7A-20, 49-7A-22, and 49-7A-26.


