- iv. limiting number of tickets submitted daily by one contractor was reviewed. Bleau LaFave added discussion regarding dynamic time, adjusting the start date and time for locates with positive response.
- v. Removal of flags was discussed along with who would be responsible for pulling flags at the end of the job?
